 - h) National Guard
 - i) Swim up movie
- 4) Discussed if there is enough time to coordinate an event for this year. After some discussion there may not be for this year.
- 5) The budget for the 21- 22 fiscal year had to be used to allow us to have a July 4th fireworks display. The next round of funds would not be available until July 1st, but this could jeopardize planning for an event in 2023.
- 6) Discussed moving the event to September, but it would not be able to include the pool.
- 7) Some new events that could be added are water polo, a chili cook off, corn hole, inviting the boy scouts
- 8) Discussed some possible dates in late August. This will be brought to the full board to discuss.
- 9) We will check with some of the vendors who are harder to schedule first for their availability.
