

NORTHWOOD POOL GROUP VISIT POLICIES

Hello And welcome to Northwood Pool, we have a simple set of guidelines that each group attending the pool must follow. These guidelines are for your group safety and our staff safety. We hope to make your visit a great time for all. If you have any questions please just reach out to Michael Rowe for any clarification.

1. Each group must follow the rules that are posted as you enter the pool area
2. Your group will be located in one central spot inside the pool fence
3. Your group must have some type of swimming level identification (ie. wrist band, colored shirt) which states what part of the pool they can be in
4. Your staff is in control of your group at all times, The lifeguards job is to watch the pool so everyone is safe
5. You need to do a head count every 15 min of the people in your group
6. We will on a busy day have everyone exit the pool at 10 mins to the hour for bathroom breaks, sunscreen reapplication and a headcount
7. If you are a large group over 15 you will need to have staff in the pool with your kiddo's
8. There is NO running on the concrete area of the pool
9. There is NO DIVING in the shallow ends of the pool (Marked in RED)
10. No horse playing IE. throwing kids, jumping over kids or any type of toy in the big pool during general swim
11. Only 1 person on the diving board at a time (must wait till the person in water is at the ladder until the next person can jump)
12. Deep end swim will only be allowed if the lifeguard says so
13. The Kiddie Pool is for those that can't swim and there is NO splashing or running in the kiddie pool
14. You are responsible for your kiddo's once they leave the pool and pool area
15. We have plenty of games they can play inside the pool area such as pingpong, basketball, ladder ball and cornhole to name a few. Please just ask the lifeguards when using the equipment and return it when you are done
