MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

The full list of basic requirements are listed in the police section of the Town's website.

- Must be 20 Years Old
- Must have permission to work in the U.S. under federal law
- Must Possess a valid driver's license
- Minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent
- Have no felony convictions

SALARY:

Entry level patrol salary range is from \$25.00 to \$27.88 an hour, depending on experience and Vermont Certification level. This salary range will change on July 1, 2026 and be between \$30.00 to \$34.00 an hour depending on experience and Vermont Certification level.

BENEFITS:

Vermont Municipal Retirement System (VMERS) Group D which offers a retirement age of 50 with a minimum of 20 years of service in the system.
