

RUTLAND TOWN SELECTBOARD REC COMMITTEE MEETING

June 30th, 2026

The Rec Committee of the Rutland Town Selectboard met at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, June 30th, 2026, at the Municipal Town Hall. Present were Selectboard Member Sharon Russell, Selectboard Member Matt Getty, Town Rec Director Mike Rowe, and Town Administrator Bill Sweet.

Discussed the current diving board.

1. They are expected to last 7 to 10 years. Ours is older.
2. Maintenance tasks have been done to try to extend its life.
3. It will need to be replaced soon. They cost approximately \$6000.
4. The Board will need to approve the expense if it comes from depreciation.

The person currently doing the maintenance work at Dewey Field is leaving soon.

1. One of the lifeguards is interested in taking over.
2. He does some of the maintenance tasks at Northwood now.
3. The committee members did not have any concerns

Discussed the Community Day event in August.

1. Last year, the Sundae Sisters donated ice cream.
 - a. In the years before that, the Foleys donated it. Donations going forward are unlikely.
 - b. Discussed purchasing it or having the Sundae Sisters provide it and we cover their cost.
 - c. For 200 people it would be approximately \$1100. The final cost would be based on actual sales.
2. Mike is taking care of ordering the food.
3. The agreement to use the caterpillar cart has been drafted. This will include insurance coverage.

Met with engineers for designing the new pool recently.

1. They asked a lot of questions and are working on a plan.
2. They told us about a different style pump we could use which could reduce our energy costs. This is being looked into.

There are about 10 different events or vendors coming to the July 3rd event.
